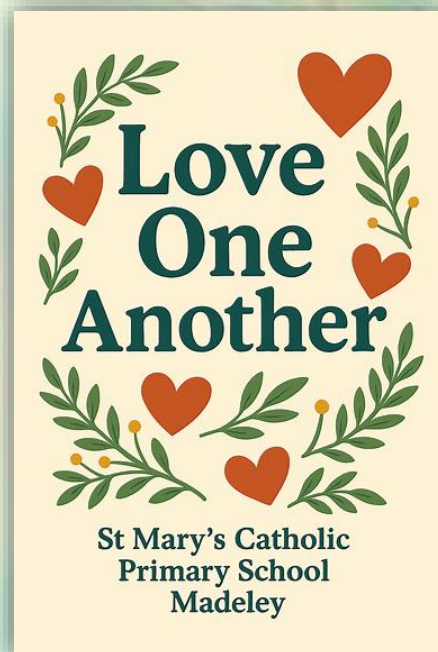

### Family Hubs in Telford and Wrekin: Supporting Families Every Step of the Way

Family Hubs in Telford and Wrekin are community-based centres designed to bring together a wide range of services for children, young people, and their families. They provide a welcoming and accessible place where families can find information, advice, and practical support, from early pregnancy right through to young adulthood.

The aim of the Family Hub model is to make it easier for families to get the help they need, when they need it, all in one place. By working in partnership with health services, schools, local organisations, and community groups, Family Hubs offer a coordinated approach to supporting families and improving outcomes for children and young people.

### What support is available?

Family Hubs in Telford and Wrekin offer a wide variety of services, including early years support such as advice on child development, parenting programmes, and stay-and-play sessions. They also provide access to health services, including health visitors, midwives, and support for emotional wellbeing.

In addition, there are youth services offering activities, mentoring, and guidance for young people. Families can also receive support with parenting challenges, relationships, and behaviour, as well as advice and guidance on education, employment, and local services.

Some hubs also provide specialist support for families facing more complex challenges, ensuring that help is tailored to individual needs.

A welcoming space for the community



Family Hubs are open to everyone and are designed to be safe, friendly, and inclusive spaces. Families can drop in for a chat, attend organised sessions, or access targeted support. By bringing services together under one roof, the hubs help reduce barriers and make support more accessible.

### Why Family Hubs matter

By supporting families early and building strong connections within the community, Family Hubs play a key role in improving children's wellbeing, strengthening family relationships, and helping parents feel more confident and supported. They also help professionals work more closely together, ensuring that families receive the right support at the right time.
